## **Special Education/Early Start Program for Infants** and Toddlers

For children under 36 months with orthopedic, hearing and/or visual disabilities and who are not eligible for GGRC Lanterman Act Program.

#### **Individualized Education Program (IEP)**

Therapy/Occupational Therapy Support

For students with long term needs that affect their ability to learn at school.

#### Neuromuscular Rehabilitation/Long-Term Physical California Children's Services Medical Therapy Unit

Individuals under age 21 requiring long term physical and/or occupational therapy support AND who present with CCS Medical Therapy Program eligible conditions.

Eligible conditions include but are not limited to those with signs of spasticity related to cerebral palsy or traumatic brain injuries, neuromuscular diseases (e.g., muscular dystrophy), musculoskeletal diseases (e.g., arthrogryposis), spina bifida, and brachial plexus injury.

Children under age 3 with a neurologic injury putting them at risk for cerebral palsy may be eligible.
